# Financial Aid & Scholarships Overview For NSU Students

- oStudents must complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to apply for federal and some state aid (Go Grant, SEOG and Federal Work Study).
- oFAFSA application must be completed each academic year (fall, spring, and summer) online <a href="https://www.studentaid.gov">www.studentaid.gov</a>
- **oWhen completing the 2025-2026 FAFSA, family income from the 2023 tax year information is required to determine federal student aid eligibility.**
- oFAFSA applications for both 2024-25 & 2025-26 academic year are now available!

### ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS NEEDED FOR AID



- Title IV Authorization Form (completed within MyNSU one time only)
- Terms and Conditions (completed within MyNSU one time only)
- o The Federal Government may select the students FAFSA application for a review process known as **Verification** that requires FA Staff to verify the accuracy of the FAFSA application.
  - •Students and parents will be required in some cases to submit tax/wage information as well as other documentation to verify the data reported on the FAFSA.
- Students will be notified via Email of the required documentation needed for any verification review



- The Intent to Attend will be available during the first 7 days of class via myNSU each semester
- OAid will not disburse to a students account until the student has verified that they will be attending their courses
- OStudents who have not completed the intent to attend within the first 7 days of classes will have their courses cancelled thereafter
- Students who do not have enough aid to cover their total balance will be required to complete a promissory agreement with NSU during the Intent to Attend process.

## **Awarding Process**

- After all FA requirements including paperwork and/or verification is completed a financial aid package will be certified for the student based on the FAFSA detail.
- oStudents will receive email notifications of their award amounts to view via their myNSU accounts
- oPell Grants & State awards (if eligible) will automatically be accepted on the student's behalf
- OStudents will need to log into MyNSU to accept/decline student loans offers
  - Note: **Subsidized loans** interest is paid by the federal government while a student is attending school for a total of **6 hours** or more.
  - Unsubsidized loans interest accrues daily
- o If the student accepts their loan awards a master promissory note and loan entrance counseling must be completed on <a href="www.studentaid.gov">www.studentaid.gov</a>

## Additional Funding Opportunities (Links are available within MyNSU and the Financial Aid website)

#### oAlumni Foundation Scholarships

- OA variety of scholarships are available through the generous donations to our university
- Application required
- Tuition Hardship Exemption
  - oUp to \$300 per semester awarded to eligible LA residents (non-TOPS eligible students)
  - Application required
- OParent Plus Loan
  - oLoans for parents of dependent students, based on credit
  - The parent must complete the application <u>www.studentaid.gov</u>
    - oApproval can be awarded up to the students Cost of Attendance, based on the amount approved
    - oDenial awarded up to the dependent loan amounts based on classification (**This would be processed as an unsubsidized loan**)
- ○Fastweb third party scholarship search
- OAlternative Loans
  - OShould only be considered as last resort
  - oBased on applicants' credit

#### **ACADEMIC PROGRESS FOR FEDERAL AID**

- Satisfactory Academic Progress guidelines for Federal Aid includes all the following:
  - Cumulative GPA of 2.0 for Undergraduate
  - Cumulative completion rate of 67% of all courses (hours earned divided by hours attempted)
     NOTE: All withdrawn courses count in attempted hours
  - Cannot attempt more than 150% of hours needed for respective program
    - (Program requires 120 for graduation, if a student attempts over 180 hours, they are no longer eligible for federal aid without an approved Financial Aid appeal.)

#### **ACADEMIC PROGRESS FOR SCHOLARSHIPS**

Students must maintain the following for the Fall & Spring semesters:

- Full-time enrollment
- The required cumulative GPA
- Your award letter will give you eligibility requirements to maintain your scholarship

Note: Academic scholarships are not used for Summer

## Family Education Rights & Privacy Act (FERPA)

- oThe Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) is a federal law that sets forth requirements regarding the privacy of student records.
- oFERPA governs the release of these records (known as educational & financial aid records) maintained by an educational institution. When a student turns 18 years old, or enters a postsecondary institution at any age, the rights under FERPA transfer from the parents to the student.
- o Therefore, the student must have a FERPA Release Authorization Form on file with the University, before any NSU staff can discuss the student's account information with a third-party individual.
- oFERPA Release Forms in most cases, must submitted in person & can be found on our website <a href="https://www.nsula.edu/financialaid">www.nsula.edu/financialaid</a> or by visiting the University Registrar website <a href="https://www.nsula.edu/registrar">www.nsula.edu/registrar</a>

## **Important Reminders**

- o Apply for FAFSA early and apply every year
- Complete Title IV Authorization Form (completed within MyNSU one time only)
- Complete Terms and Conditions (completed within MyNSU one time only)
- Complete Intent to Attend within first 7 days of classes (every semester)
- o Book Allowances are available for students who have aid that exceeds their account balance
  - Note: NSU IncludEd Program allows the rental or purchase textbooks at a reduced costs with charges being made directly to the students' myNSU tuition & fee bill.
- Maintaining Satisfactory Academic Progress
  - Federal Aid 2.0 cumulative GPA, 67% completion rate, & not exceeding allowed attempted hours Scholarships - Required GPA/hours for TOPs along with Academic & Performance Scholarships
- o Borrow conservatively there are annual loan limits & lifetime loan limits
- o Keep copies of all financial aid paperwork, security codes, and passwords in a safe place
- o Monitor your myNSU & student account email regularly
- o Always ask questions if you are unsure of anything

## IMPORTANT BILLING REMINDERS

- o A pre-bill is sent approximately one month before the start of the semester
- Notifications are sent via NSU email and bills can be viewed through MyNSU oInstallment plans are applied for every student if account balances are not paid in full by the end of the 7<sup>th</sup> class day:
  - Installment plans split the outstanding account balance into three portions:
  - \$85 installment plan fee is applied & \$45 late fees if installments are not paid in full
- oDirect Deposit is available for refund disbursement (funds that exceeds account balance)
- oCheck emails and billing summary frequently for any updates and
- Always reach out for any questions or concerns
